
## Removing the door from the stove:

If you need to replace the glass pane or the ceramic strip, you must detach the door of the stove as follows:

- 1. Open the door with your right hand and hold the door handle;
- 2. Hold the round bar left of the glass with your left hand;
- 3. Move the bar upwards with short turning movements;
- 4. Now the door will be freed on the bottom left;
- 5. Pull the door towards you with your left hand until it is no longer resting on the hinge lid;
- 6. Now the door can be lowered and the top left area will be free.

## Fixing the ceramic 15\*5 mm strip to the door:

- 1. Remove the old strip
- 2. Completely remove the remaining glue; the bright steel bar must be visible. You can do this with an abrasive disk on a sanding machine, with sandpaper or a wire brush.
- 3. Remove all dust and grease
- 4. Apply sufficient glue in a wavy pattern (it suffices if the strips can sink into the glue and the whole surface of the strip is covered with glue)
- 5. Glue the strip to the edge and press the strip down. Ensure that the strip is applied at about 2 mm from the outer edge and NOT against the corner touching the seals, please see the drawing)
- 6. Fix the ends of the strip with glue to avoid "fraying".
- 7. You may respray the door with heat-resistant paint. It does not matter if the paint comes on the strip.
- 8. Let it dry for about 6 hours before replacing the door and using the stove.



## Replacing the door:

- 1. Hold the door as you did when removing it;
- 2. Slide the door around the top left pin;
- 3. Place the door above the hole bottom left;
- 4. Move the bar downwards with turning movements:
- 5. Now the bar will slide back into the hole and the door is mounted.
